Great Barrington – The Berkshire International Film Festival (BIFF) continues its' monthly free-screenings, April 1 at 11:00 at the Triplex Cinema with the films, *Charging The Rhino* and *Sweet Soil*.

Charging The Rhino is a deeply personal, psychologically layered and stylistically innovative film which tells the story of a family, a place and a time, flashing between a modern day pilgrimage and the history of what happened in that place sixty years ago.

Local filmmakers Laura Meister and Erica Spizz share a passion for fresh, local food. *Sweet Soil* shares the stories of four family farms, a natural foods store committed to supporting them, and a community's passion for fresh, local food. *Sweet Soil* will follow immediately after *Charging The Rhino* as part of the monthly free BIFF screening.
